

# Top Logistic and Transport Performers Recognised

The fourth Irish Logistics and Transport Awards took place before a packed audience of industry leaders with author and broadcaster Richard Curran presiding over a glittering awards ceremony which was held under the patronage of the Chartered Institute of Logistics Transport, with Topaz as this year's lead sponsor.
